2026 BOARD ELECTIONS

Thank you for your interest in nominating yourself or a colleague for election to the Board of Directors for AABH. AABH's board has 15 positions and 1/3 of those positions are elected each year. Each board term is 3 years.

The process for a board election includes:


1. Request for Nominations sent to membership
2. Nomination forms are filled out for a candidate
3. Candidates request seconds for nominations (nomination seconds must be received from organizations separate from that of the candidate.)
4. Nomination 'second' forms are sent to the nomination committee
5. Nomination committee reviews candidates for eligibility:
 - Organization is a current member in good standing for at least one full year.
 - Seconds validated as current members
6. Eligible candidates are notified of eligibility
7. Candidates complete a candidate bio form for the ballot
8. Ballot is composed
9. Ballot sent to membership (each member receives a single vote)
10. Ballots are counted
11. Candidates notified of the results
12. Members notified of results
13. New board members begin serving at August Board meeting
